- Pro Men 1-2 limited to field of 120; Women Cat 3/4/5 and Cat 4/5 limited to 75; All others limited to 100.
- OMNIUM POINTS schedule can be found in the Race Bible. Prime points will be up for grabs on both days for all categories.
- Primal Champion Jerseys to overall winners, Leader's Jerseys for Men Pro 1/2, Women Pro 1-3 only.
- Sparkling Wine for top three stage finishers, and to the top five GC finishers for Cat 4/5 and Women 3/4/5 courtesy of Wilson Creek Winery. Non-alcoholic sparkling cider for under 21 years old.

CHECK-IN, STAGING and REGISTRATION:

- Saturday Check-In starts 7:00am at the Murrieta Senior Center parking lot, located at Juniper & Adams.
- Sunday Check-In starts 7:00am at the corner of Washington & Ivy.
- Sign in and race day registration one hour before each race. Closes 10 minutes before race time.
- The Grand Prix staging area will be at the driveway between the Senior Center parking lot and the Kiddie Academy of Murrieta. Circuit Race will be at the corner of lvy Street and Washington. All riders <u>MUST</u> report to staging <u>10 minutes</u> before start for instructions. Failure to stage may be penalized.
- NO REFUNDS. Races Held Rain or Shine.
- Pre-reg strongly recommended, categories will fill and waiting lists will be created at event site only.
- One day race license available for Women and Men Category 5.
- Online Registration ONLY at bikereg.com. Deadline is 11:59PM March 30, 2023. Same day Race Registration fee is an additional <a href="mailto:state:stat
- Extra races for the same day only are \$20 each after the highest race is paid.

COURSE INFORMATION:

STAGE 1 Grand Prix: This is not your typical industrial park race course! The course has six turns, approximately one mile per lap; flat, fast, and technical. Start Finish line is on Juniper Street across the Senior Center (https://www.mapmyride.com/routes/view/26281238).

STAGE 2 Circuit Race: The course is approximately 4.2 miles per lap, mostly flat with a couple of big ring rollers; 21 gear is more than enough. Start/Finish Line is on Washington Street, just south of Ivy Street (https://ridewithgps.com/routes/29052228).

DIRECTIONS and PARKING:

Grand Prix (Saturday): Park in surrounding streets. Do not park in private business parking lots and where "No Parking Signs" are erected. DO NOT PARK IN THE LIBRARY OR SENIOR CENTER PARKING LOTS

<u>Circuit Race (Sunday)</u>: Park in Old Town Murrieta along Washington Street. Do not park on Ivy Street across registration and north of Washington Street (N/E corner of Ivy and Washington), and in business' parking lots. <u>You will either be cited or towed</u>. Businesses will be open for business and we do not want to take their spots.

Team Competition Awards:
